

DISCOVER DRY ICE

A block of Penguin Brand **DRY ICE** adds the perfect touch to an eerie Halloween party. With dry ice you can change the atmosphere from uninspired to spine-chilling. With a few household items, and some choice Halloween props, bubbling, misting drinks and fogging food displays can be made with ease. Use your imagination and follow safe handling guidelines in this brochure to create really cool Halloween special effects and recipes

The Witches Brew

Dressed as a dreadful witch, start by filling a plastic cauldron, which can be purchased from a local arts and crafts store, with ½ gallon of grape juice, 1 can pineapple juice, and ½ gallon of extra pulpy orange juice. Stir mixture together with your witches broom. Using tongs, add a few small pieces of Penguin Brand **DRY ICE** to the mixture, recite some witches heckles, and the bubbling mixture becomes a scary witches brew. Add gummy worms or grapes for creepy effects.

Serve the brew while still bubbling being careful not to serve dry ice to your guests. You can make several versions of this brew, substituting the juice for soda and adding alcohol for the adults. If using ginger ale or white grape juice, add a few glow sticks, found at arts and crafts stores, to the liquid to create a creepy glowing affect.

The Wizard's Potion

(Spooky Home-Made Root Beer)
Home-made root beer is a delicious treat for any Halloween party. Start by pouring one gallon of water in a large container, followed by two cups of sugar and one ounce of root beer extract, found at most grocery stores. Once the sugar is dissolved, add two pounds of **DRY ICE** (broken into smaller pieces). The bubbling mixture will become carbonated and ready to serve when all the **DRY ICE** has fully vaporized. This recipe works great for any other flavors such as banana, coconut or orange. Add ice cream for a special root beer float that kids of all ages will love.

Bewitching Misting Drinks

Every Halloween party needs a misting centerpiece to add extra scary effects to the food table. To create the misting effect, use two plastic or metal containers, one larger than the other. Place the smaller container inside the larger one, and fill it with the desired beverage. Using tongs, place several small pieces of **DRY ICE** to the larger container. Add a small

amount of hot water. Spooky fog will surround the punch as your guests select their favorite foods from your ghostly table. Serve the beverage from the smaller container and add more hot water or **DRY ICE** as needed to continue creating the spooky fog.

Ghostly Fog

Producing an air of mystery and fright, low hanging fog is the ultimate special effect for an evening Halloween bash. To create a foggy room, add a few cups of hot water to a large crock pot. Be sure the crock pot is turned on so that water stays hot. Using tongs, add a few small pieces of **DRY ICE** to create the ghostly fog. The hotter the water and smaller the piece of **DRY ICE**, the more fog will be produced.

A food or display table is a perfect place for clouds of creepy fog. Just put the dry ice and hot water in a low-sided container towards the back of the table. Since fog given off by dry ice is denser than air, the fog will spill over the sides of the container and hang low on the table, blanketing the refreshments and food in a cloud of spooky fog.

Smoking Bubbles

Trick or treaters will love this smoking bubble tree. This simple trick requires Penguin Brand **DRY ICE**, warm water, a tablespoon of dish detergent and a small witch's cauldron. Begin by placing the **DRY ICE** and hot water in the container, then add the detergent. Big bubbles will form out of the dry ice that, when popped, will give off puffs of smoke. Add a small amount of orange food coloring for special effect.

Smoking Pumpkin and Spooky Graveyard

Simply put a container with a small piece of **DRY ICE** and hot water in a carved pumpkin. Fog should immediately begin to rise, spilling out all of the holes carved in the pumpkin. For even more effect, crack a few glow sticks, available at arts and crafts stores, and place them inside, next to the container of **DRY ICE**. Another fun Halloween display is a graveyard and the low hanging fog adds the perfect ghostly touch. Simply put a pan with **DRY ICE** and hot water behind each tombstone and watch as the area fills in an eerie mist.
